

# **FY2015 IT Plan Highlights**

## **430 PRC – Public Regulation Commission**

### **Executive Summary:**

1. The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission's (PRC) plan for Information Technology (IT) is to use technology as a tool and vehicle to fulfill its vision, achieve its mission and accomplish its programmatic goals. The PRC has strategically aligned its IT projects, short term and long term, to support the goals of each of its programs.

### **Agency Description:**

1. The New Mexico Public Regulation Commission, created in Article XI, Section 2 of the Constitution of New Mexico, is composed of five commissioners elected from districts as provided in that article and the Public Regulation Commission Apportionment Act, NMSA 1978, section 8-7-1.
2. The Commission consists of four performance based programs which are broken down as follows: Policy and Regulation (78.7 FTE), Public Safety (52.3 Perm FTE, 1 Term FTE), Program Support (22 Perm FTE). The agency is complemented with 153 Perm FTE 1 Term FTE's total.
